This tooth cannot be saved and needs to come out.

Will the extraction hurt?

You will feel pressure, but no pain.

I'm going to numb the area first.

Bite down on this gauze for twenty minutes.

Don't rinse your mouth for the first twenty-four hours.

Avoid hot drinks and smoking today.

The stitches will dissolve on their own.

Some swelling over the next two days is normal.

How long will the socket take to heal?

Come back if the bleeding doesn't stop.

The wisdom tooth is lying against the nerve.

We may need to remove it in sections.

Take a painkiller before the anaesthetic wears off.

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
